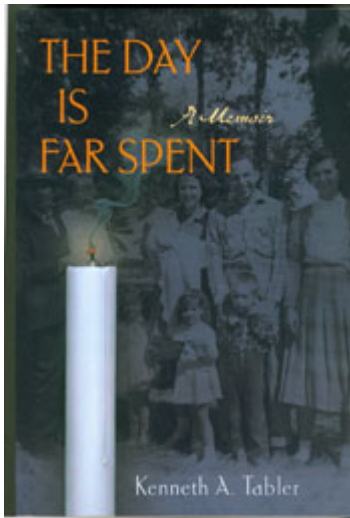


## Appalachian History - this newly published 1930s W.Va. memoir has it in spades
