The first thing you have to check is your Internet Explorer browser.

- Open your Internet Explorer.

- Now, go to the programs tab and check the option for IE to do a default browser check the next time when it starts.
- After this, click on the Apply button and finally press OK button.
- Now, close all the Internet Explorer browsers and then start the Internet Explorer.
- Click on the Yes option and make Internet Explorer as your default web browser.
- Finally, close the Outlook Express and start its back up.

If still your problem is not resolved after following these steps then another possibility can be that your Outlook Express is configured to read email in the plain text.

- Open your Outlook Express account.
- Visit the Tools menu and select Options there.
- Now, go to the Read tab.
- Here, uncheck the box for all 'Read all message in plain text'.
- Finally, click on the Apply button and press the OK button.

If you not succeed in the above two options, then lastly, third option is to try is the Outlook Express Security Options.

- Open your Outlook Express account.
- After that, move to the Tools menu and select Options.
- Now, go to the Security tab.
- Uncheck the box for 'Do not allow attachments to be saved or opened if they could potentially be a virus'.
- Click on the Apply button and then finally, press OK.
- Restart your Outlook Express.

With the help of these steps you can easily resolve the issues related to email links in your Outlook account.
